2023 CABERNET SAUVIGNON NAPA COUNTY

VINTAGE

The 2023 grape harvest in Napa is being celebrated as one of the most exceptional vintages in recent memory. A combination of favorable weather conditions and meticulous vineyard management contributed to the outstanding quality of the grapes. The season began with higher-than-average rainfall during winter and spring, replenishing soil moisture and leading to a successful bloom. Cooler spring temperatures delayed the growing season by 10–14 days compared to 2022, but the mild summer weather, with temperatures ranging from 72–75°F, allowed for extended hang-time. This prolonged ripening period enabled grapes to develop deep color, concentrated flavors, and balanced acidity.

VINEYARD

The fruit for the 2023 Cabernet Sauvignon was harvested from the Foley Johnson Rutherford Property.

WINEMAKING

These grapes were hand harvested in the early morning. Once brought to the winery they were destemmed to a stainless steel tank and underwent a 2-day cold soak. The wine was then inoculated with yeast and pumped over daily during fermentation. Once fermentation was complete, the tank was pressed and racked to 30% new French and American oak barrels. In barrel, the wine underwent malolactic fermentation and then aged for 18 months.

WINEMAKER NOTES

The 2023 Napa Cabernet Sauvignon opens with cassis, milk chocolate, toasted oak, marshmallow, ripe blackberry, and forest floor. The palate is dark and bold with chewy tannins providing excellent grip and a long finish. This powerhouse wine pairs perfectly with flank steak, or aged cheddar cheese.
